Why did I get this information Sheet?

You have identified that you have a Penicillin/Amoxicillin allergy. It is now recommended that everyone (<u>Adults and Children</u>) with a Penicillin or Amoxicillin allergy get allergy testing done as 95% of people are not actually allergic to these antibiotics and 80% of people grow out of their allergy after 10 years. The testing we do in Winnipeg is <u>extremely safe</u>, <u>does not involve any needles</u>, and is being done all over the world. Our goal is to safely remove as many 'false' penicillin and amoxicillin allergies in Winnipeg as possible.

Benefits to Surgery Patients by Removing Penicillin/Amoxicillin Allergy

- Allows surgery patients to receive the best antibiotics to prevent infection during surgery instead of stronger, more expensive antibiotics with more side effects such as Vancomycin
- Shorter length of surgery
- Lower chance of wound infection after surgery
- Lower chance of infection after joint replacement surgery
- Shorter stay in hospital
- Less expensive than other antibiotics (53% savings) and less side effects
- Less bacterial resistance which is better for everyone in our society
- Lower chance of getting a bad skin infection (MRSA) or severe diarrhea (C. diff) while in hospital
